DELAWARE'S MINIMUM & MAXIMUM WORKERS' COMPENSATION RATES CHANGED

Each year, the state of Delaware's minimum and maximum workers' compensation rates are adjusted based on the average weekly wage from the prior calendar year.

The Secretary of Labor for the Delaware Department of Labor announced the average weekly wage in Delaware for calendar year 2010 was \$933.08. Based on this figure, effective June 13, 2011, the maximum weekly compensation rate for workers' compensation benefits will be \$622.05, and the minimum weekly compensation rate will be \$207.35.
